THE ART PIECE IS NEAR THE ENTRANCE BEHIND THE WINDOW.

This work from our tour, called 'Connection', originated from inspiring conversations with people and target groups in and around Kortrijk. It invites you to see the literal connection between people, Europe, and pieces of fabric.

As a group, we have brought it all together, but the connection between all those pieces of fabric is the work of the people we engaged in conversation with. From someone in an elderly home to someone simply relaxing, to someone enthusiastically learning Dutch.

We met people from CVO Miras, WZC 't Hoge, CAW and a woman from Vondels. Dialogue is at the heart of this work, along with stories.

Everyone and every piece of fabric has a story, but it is about the connection between them. Symbolically interweaving cultures, fabrics, backgrounds and people.
